Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Most places will have a frosty start, the frost sharp in places.  
However, for most places, the day will be dry with plenty of  
sunshine. There will be more cloud close to eastern coasts and here  
there is just a risk of a light shower. It will still feel chilly,  
despite lighter winds.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

It will remain mostly dry with clear, frosty nights and plenty of  
sunshine by day, but there will be an increasing risk of overnight  
fog patches. Later on Friday, milder conditions with outbreaks of  
rain will spread to northwest Scotland on freshening westerly winds.
