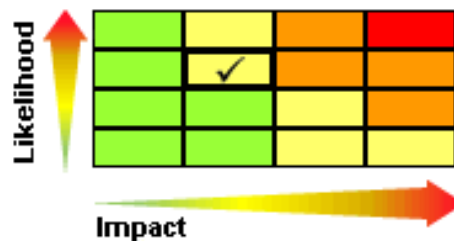
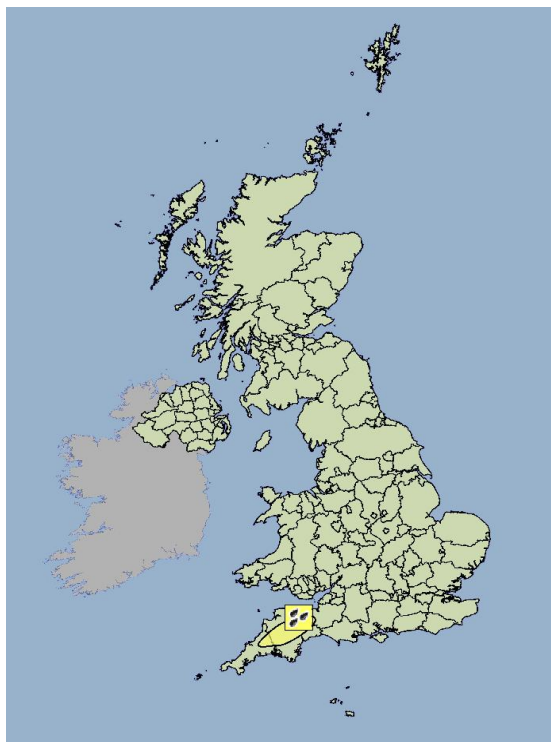




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A band of persistent and heavy slow moving showers has developed this afternoon and is bringing some locally torrential downpours to some areas. The showers are expected to slowly ease through this evening.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **17:50 on Sun, 30th Jul 2017** until **20:00 on Sun, 30th Jul 2017**

A narrow band of heavy, thundery showers is bringing some locally torrential downpours.

Localised flooding of prone sections of road could disrupt travel, whilst minor flooding of land, homes and businesses are also possible.
