for the period 0600 UTC Tuesday 04 November to 0600 UTC Wednesday 05 November

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure over the United Kingdom will gradually move away eastwards, allowing a cool northerly airflow to develop for a time. Winds will then decrease as a ridge of high pressure moves eastwards ahead of the next deep Atlantic low that will spread unsettled and windy conditions eastwards on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Slight at first in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4, veering north or northeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough and very rough towards Rattray Head.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, becoming variable, then south later, 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest, then north later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3 for a time.

Slight.

Showers, mainly in south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northerly 5 or 6, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming mainly moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly becoming cyclonic, mainly northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, and again later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Thundery showers, mainly in east.

Good, occasionally moderate in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest veering north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Rough in far west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 or 6 later.

Rough at first in west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Moderate or rough.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers at first in west.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly veering northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming slight for a time.  
Showers at first.  
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northeast 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North or northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 2 or 3, then veering south 4 or 5 later.  
Mainly moderate becoming slight.  
Showers then fair.  
Mainly good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north, veering northeasterly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time in north.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly veering southeasterly 4 or 5, then veering southerly 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.  
Showers later.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6, veering northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly veering southeasterly 4 or 5, then veering southerly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Showers later.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time, veering northeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in far west.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, then veering south 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers then fair.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, then very rough for a time in north.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, decreasing 4 later.

Very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then fair.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will cover the North Sea on Tuesday with a strong northeast airflow over Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8

Northeast 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov:

Northeast 6 or 7, decreasing 5 in northwest.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later in southwest.

Showers dying out.

Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, locally 5, increasing 4 to 5 this afternoon, further veering northwest to north increasing 5 to 6 for a time overnight.

Slight to moderate becoming moderate to rather rough this afternoon.

Scattered showers, locally with thunder.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 in the evening, becoming variable 2 or 3 overnight, then southerly by morning.

Moderate locally rather rough at first, becoming slight with a low swell.

Isolated showers, dying out overnight.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

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
