Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

A complex Atlantic low will push its fronts and troughs across the United Kingdom during the rest of Tuesday and during Wednesday, maintaining an unsettled picture around the coastline for much of the time.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north and near Rattray Head.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 at times in north.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Rattray Head.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, veering south 3 or 4 later.

Thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 later.

Thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering westerly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 later.

Thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good.

Slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest 3 or 4, backing south later.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good.

Slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, perhaps 6 at times around the Isles of Scilly.

Rain at first, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Slight or moderate, but rough in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, perhaps 6 at first around St Davids Head.

Rain at first, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Slight or moderate, but rough in west.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, but 3 or 4 in east.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Moderate or rough, but slight in east.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 at times in north.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Slight or moderate, but rough in northwest.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Moderate or rough.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Rain then showers.

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Rain then showers.
