General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure will move across the United Kingdom during Thursday bringing lighter winds for a time, before a stronger southwesterly flow moves into northern areas overnight into Friday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 to 7, veering north 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate or rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing west 3 or 4 later, then backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Variable 2 or 3, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.
Good, becoming moderate for a time in Bristol Channel.

Easterly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly later 3 or 4, then veering westerly 4 or 5 later in far west.

Smooth or slight.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Variable, mainly northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time in far north.

Smooth or slight.

Drizzle for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Variable 2 or 3, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then rain or showers.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then rain or showers.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, veering northeast 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north.

Rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwesterly 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Occasional drizzle at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Rain or showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

The Minch - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure will move east across Shetland on Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7 decreasing 3 or 4, backing westerly later in west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Showers dying out.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Thursday 02 Nov until 0000 UTC on Friday 03 Nov:

West or northwest 3 or 4 backing southwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough.

Fair.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 4, locally 2 near brittany coast, becoming north or variable 1 to 3 by noon, then northeast to east by evening, and east to southeast, occasionally 4 in the south, by Friday.

Slight or smooth.

Risk of mist patches near french coasts in the morning and again late evening.

Good, perhaps moderate to poor near french coasts morning and evening.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to southeast 2 to 3, increasing 3 to 4 by midday, veering southeast to south in the evening.

Smooth or slight.

Patchy light rain or drizzle mist and a risk of fog patches spreading from french coasts in the morning.

Good becoming moderate, locally poor perhaps very poor.

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
