Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Tuesday 01 June to 1200 UTC Wednesday 02 June 2021

#### General Situation

The ridge over the North Sea will decline for a time this evening and into Wednesday, as a thundery low over Biscay will move north or northwest towards Ireland and weaken before moving west into the Atlantic on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in inner Moray Firth.

Fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first and later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight becoming smooth or slight.

Fog patches becoming extensive fog for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight becoming slight.

Fog patches becoming extensive fog for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Extensive fog becoming fair, fog patches later.

Poor or very poor becoming moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches becoming extensive fog for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight becoming slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4 backing northeast 2 or 3.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Showers later.  
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.  
Smooth or slight becoming slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly 4 becoming variable 3 or less.  
Slight, occasionally smooth later in the wash and Thames estuary.  
Showers later.  
Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight becoming mainly slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then westerly 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 4 or 5.  
Slight, occasionally smooth near shore.  
Showers, perhaps thundery.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East 4 becoming variable 3 or less then southwest 3 or 4.  
Slight becoming smooth, then smooth or slight later.  
Showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
East 4 or 5 veering southeast 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 3 or 4 veering southwest 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Lyme bay.  
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, but smooth in east and moderate in southwest, occasionally moderate later in northwest.

Thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4 veering south 3 to 5, then southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.

Thundery showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 to 4 veering east 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 to 6, veering south 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far southwest and far northwest.

Showers, fog patches later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 2 to 4 backing east or northeast 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 increasing 5 or 6, becoming variable 4 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 2 or 3 backing northeast 3 or 4, veering east 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming smooth, then slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 to 6, veering south 3 or 4 later.

Slight becoming slight or moderate for a time, occasionally smooth later in northeast.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less, becoming east 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, but moderate in northwest.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 to 5, increasing 6, veering southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 4 to 6, veering southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Showers later.

Mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 2 to 4, veering north 4 or 5, then east 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4 increasing 5, veering southeast 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming variable, 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north and in south.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 2 to 4, veering east or southeast 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and in far south.

Showers later.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming variable, 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming northeast 2 to 4, veering east or southeast 4 to 6.

Moderate, occasionally slight later.

Showers later.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Tuesday 01 Jun 2021 at 1200 UTC until Wednesday 02 Jun 2021 at 0000 UTC

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

High pressure across Scandinavia maintains a southerly flow over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 or 3 for a time in northwest.

Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 02 Jun until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 02 Jun:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, but variable 2 or 3 at first in northwest.

Moderate, but slight in waters east of Shetland.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4 later tonight, then variable 1 to 3, becoming southerly 3 to 4, occasionally 5, later tomorrow morning in the south of the area.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain for a time after midnight, locally heavy, possibly thundery becoming misty later.

Good or very good, becoming mostly moderate, locally poor later.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 2 to 4, becoming cyclonic, then becoming variable, mainly west to northwest, 1 to 3 by late evening.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell in the west.

Misty at times.

Moderate to poor, occasionally good.

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
