General Situation

Deep low will move away northeastwards into the North Sea on Monday. Then two Atlantic low centres will slowly move east on Tuesday and merge to the southwest of Ireland later.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4, increasing 5 to 7, backing southwest 4 later.

Slight or moderate, but rough, occasionally very rough, in northwest.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4, backing east or southeast 5 or 6, then backing northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far north.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, becoming northwest, 5 to 7, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain at first, showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9, becoming west or northwest 6 or 7, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough offshore.

Rain or squally showers until later.

Good, occasionally moderate until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly 5 to 7, backing southwesterly later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southerly 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southerly 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Squally showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6 at first in east, otherwise northwesterly 4 or 5, backing westerly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 to 7, backing southwesterly 4 or 5, then southeasterly 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west 6 to gale 8, then southwest 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate near shore.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate near shore.

Squally showers at first, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, backing west 6 to gale 8, then southwest 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 6 to gale 8.
Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.
Squally showers at first, rain later.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 5 or 6, backing southwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far south.
Squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 4 or 5, then southeast 5 to 7 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far south and slight later in north.
Squally showers at first, rain later.
Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, backing west 4 or 5, then southwest 5 to 7 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, backing southeast 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first, becoming slight later.
Showers at first, rain later.
Good, becoming moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 5 or 6, backing southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Rain becoming fair, showers later.
Moderate or poor becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, backing west 4 or 5, then southwest 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly 5 or 6, backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.

Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.
Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in shelter.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, then variable 3 or 4, then becoming easterly 4 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.
Squally showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 5 to 7, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first in central areas.
Squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 or 6, backing southeast, becoming cyclonic, then east later, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in central areas.
Showers at first.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 5 to 7, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.
Rough or very rough.
Squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 or 6, backing southeast, becoming cyclonic, then east later, 5 to 7.
Rough, occasionally very rough at first.
Showers at first.
Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Monday 04 Mar 2019 at 0000 UTC until Monday 04 Mar 2019 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A large complex area of low pressure remains slow moving close to Shetland through Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil (Gale now ceased issued 03/1553UTC)

South or southwest 3 or 4 becoming cyclonic 4 or 5

Rough or very rough, becoming mainly moderate in southeast
Showers
Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Mar until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Mar:

Cyclonic, becoming north or northeast later, 5 to 7
Moderate in southeast at first, otherwise rough or very rough
Rain or showers
Moderate or good, perhaps poor at times

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8 with gusts to 55kt, perhaps severe gale 9 for a time with gusts to 60kt in the south of the area towards dawn then veering west to northwest 5 to 6, backing west 6 to gale 8 by midday, backing west to southwest 5 to 7 by evening.

Rather rough to rough, increasing very rough for a time overnight and again Monday afternoon.

Showers, locally heavy and prolonged, with risk of hail and thunder.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 7, backing southwest to south 4 to 5 late morning, backing southwest to south 6 to 7 by evening.

Rather rough to rough, locally very rough mid-channel at first, decreasing moderate to rather rough with swell in the afternoon, locally rough in the evening.

Scattered showers, locally heavy.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
