Forecast for Sunday 01 May 2022

Weather: Outbreaks of rain and drizzle early morning with extensive low cloud and mist. This will fizzle out through the morning with skies brightening and cloud bases lifting. Bright, perhaps sunny spells during the afternoon and early evening with the chance of a shower. Cloud expected to become extensive and lower again later in the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: Nil to 20% early morning, becoming 80% by mid-afternoon, falling 40% later in the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Poor or very poor in drizzle, mist and low cloud. Becoming mostly good or very good during the afternoon. Extensive cloud, base 300 to 600m during the early morning, this lifting near or above the summits in the afternoon, then lowering again in the evening.

Forecast for Monday 02 May 2022

Weather: Overnight and early morning low cloud, mist and drizzle, this clearing to leave a mainly dry and bright day with a few sunny breaks possible along with a scattering of showers.

Maximum wind: North 10mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% overnight and early morning, becoming 80% in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Poor or very poor in early low cloud, mist and drizzle, becoming good or very good, but moderate in any showers. Occasional or extensive cloud, base 600m or less, soon lifting and breaking above the summits.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 Celsius rising to 15 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 3 to 7 Celsius
Freezing level: Above the summits.
