




Yellow warning

Heavy rain and thunderstorms could produce flooding in a few areas.

What to expect

- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Where flooding occurs, there is a chance of delays or cancellations to train and bus services
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- There is a small chance that either flooding or lightning strikes could lead to power cuts or loss of other services to some homes and businesses

Further details

Another day with the possibility that thundery weather could cause impacts due to flooding, lightning or possible large hail. Many parts will be wet and cloudy but only a few seem likely to see the heaviest downpours. At present it is East Anglia that looks perhaps most likely to see hourly totals in excess of 20 mm, with a few spots perhaps seeing 40-60 mm in 2-3 hours.

Reason for update

The warning area has been extended south and west.
