General Situation

High pressure persists across the United Kingdom. A weak cold front over Scotland will move southwards across most areas by late Wednesday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south at first.

Mainly slight.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Smooth or slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 becoming northerly 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Smooth increasing slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 becoming northerly 3 or 4.

Smooth increasing slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in east, becoming variable 3 in west.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times, with daytime sea breezes.

Variable 3 or 4, with daytime sea breezes.

Variable 3 or 4, with daytime sea breezes.

24 hour forecast:
Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

24 hour forecast:

Northwest veering north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
