Forecast for Thursday 03 Feb 2022

Weather: Mostly dry with clear or sunny spells, the cloud may thicken up at times over western hills to give a few outbreaks of drizzle at times. Cloud increases through the evening, perhaps bringing outbreaks of occasionally heavy rain by midnight.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Around 40% in west but 80% in east. Chances fall to zero through the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional cloud will obscure highest hills above 600m, but some patches down to 450m in the west. Otherwise visibility good or rather hazy falling, and to several kilometres in any drizzle and heavy evening rain.

Meteorologist's View

A generally fine day, although navigation may be difficult at times across western hills with low cloud. Winds strengthening to give a notable chill, and gusts of around 50mph during the evening.

Forecast for Friday 04 Feb 2022

Weather: Heavy rain after midnight turns to snow through the early hours above 500m, before clearing southeast towards dawn with long clear spells developing. Then a bright, cold day with sunny spells and, especially in the west, occasionally heavy shower. These falling as snow above 300m during the morning before the snow-line rises to around 500m during the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 35-40 mph with gusts 45-55mph, perhaps briefly 60-65mph with heaviest rain at first. Becoming westerly 25-30mph with gusts 35-40mph once early rain clears.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: Around 70% in west but nearer 90% in east

Low cloud and visibility: Periods of cloud at times in west obscuring hills above 500m but cloud more occasional above 600m in the east. Otherwise visibility, very good falling to a kilometre or less in snow showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Zero rising to Plus 6 Celsius
At 600m: Minus 1 Celsius
Freezing level: 400m, rising to 700m later
