Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

Low pressure slow moving near Scotland. Rain or showers for all areas. Strong winds in the south.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Easterly, becoming variable for a time, 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers and fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming westerly 3 or 4 for a time in south.

Thundery showers, with fog patches mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, becoming southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4 increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Showers, some thundery.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, increasing 6 or 7 for a time near North Foreland.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Moderate or rough.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest, veering west for a time, 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6,  
occasionally 7.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 4 or 5 occasionally 6 overnight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly veering northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.  
Rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde  
and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly or southwesterly, becoming variable later, 2 or 3,  
occasionally 4.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly becoming variable then northwesterly 2 or 3,  
occasionally 4.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.  
Rain or showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Rain at times, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

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
