Forecast for Tuesday 06 Dec 2022

Weather: A few clear spells overnight with perhaps a frost in places, but rather cloudy and still some showery outbreaks of light rain and possibly a touch wintry on the tops. Then a rather cold day and mostly cloudy in morning with showers, these wintry above 400m, but most will be over the north and east and tending to fade away and becoming brighter. Generally dry through the afternoon with sunny spells then clear periods in evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 70%, but closer to 30% in north and east in morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Good visibility but moderate in rain showers and very poor in snow and within cloud with bases quite widespread down to 500m at first in north and east, but occasionally broken above 700 or 800m elsewhere and mostly patches or scattered cloud around 700m in afternoon and evening.

Meteorologist's View

Some chill effect at all levels, but generally light winds. Freezing level lowering through the day

Forecast for Wednesday 07 Dec 2022

Weather: Cold, bright and frosty, though rather cloudy at times and there could be the odd wintry shower. Cloudier in the evening with showery outbreaks of snow edging into the west.

Maximum wind: North or northeast 10mph, but northwest 10-15 mph in evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90%, reducing to 30-50% in evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Mostly very good visibility, but poor in any snow showers by day and very poor in scattered perhaps occasionally broken cloud above 600 or 700m, but more widespread broken cloud above 600m in evening with patches down to 500m in west.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 3 C rising to plus 3 C
At 600m: Minus 4 C
Freezing level: 400m rising to 600m in west in evening
