Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 05 June to 0600 UTC Saturday 06 June 2020

General Situation

A showery northwesterly airflow will predominate at first. Thereafter, a deep area of low pressure forming over the northern North Sea today will then drift southwards close to eastern England and will bring gales to many coasts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, veering north or northeast 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north and near Rattray Head.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Moderate or rough in east, rough or very rough in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest becoming cyclonic, then northeast later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then rough or very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 to gale 8, becoming variable 3 or 4, then north 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough, then slight or moderate for a time.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming north, 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing southwest 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, becoming cyclonic, then north or northwest, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain or showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northwesterly 5 or 6, backing westerly or southwesterly 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in north.

Occasional rain then thundery showers, fair later.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering westerly 6.

Moderate or rough until later in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 or 6, backing southwesterly 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Showers, rain for a time.

Mainly good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough around headlands and in west.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight at times in eastern Bristol Channel, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, veering north or northwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, backing west 6 to gale 8 later.
Moderate, becoming rough later.
Showers, occasional rain later in north.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 or 6.
Rough becoming moderate.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, backing west 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in south.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering northwest 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 or 6.
Moderate.
Rain at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in east and rough or very rough in north.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 6 to gale 8, veering north or northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in north, becoming slight or moderate in southeast.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough and very rough at times in

northern North Channel.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, except in North Channel.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.
Moderate becoming rough or very rough.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 6 to gale 8.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north and in far southwest.
Showers, then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far north.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 6 to gale 8.
Moderate becoming rough or very rough, occasionally high for a time in west.
Showers, then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Rough or very rough.
Showers.
Good.

Valid Friday 05 Jun 2020 at 0600 UTC until Friday 05 Jun 2020 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Deepening low will move west across the North Sea towards northeast Scotland on Friday before tracking away south on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue:
Northwesterly gale force 8 expected soon, issued at 2143 UTC on Thursday 4 June 2020

North veering northeast 5 or 6
Moderate or rough
Rain then showers
Moderate becoming mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Saturday 06 Jun:

Northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4
Moderate or rough
Rain at times
Moderate or good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 4 to 6, perhaps locally 7 at times.

Moderate to rather rough, increasing rough in the north and west later, with a low swell.

Scattered showers, becoming more isolated for a time during the day.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 5 to 6, occasionally 7 during the afternoon and evening, mainly mid-channel.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate overnight, with a low swell.

Scattered showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

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
