#### General Situation

High pressure situated to the north of the United Kingdom will become centred across central England by midday Saturday, before slowly moving away eastwards during Sunday and Monday, allowing Atlantic fronts to move into northern and western parts.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable at times in inner Moray Firth, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north and later near Rattray Head.

Occasional rain later.
