


National Severe Weather Warning Service

Chief Forecasters Assessment

An active front will bring persistent and often heavy rain to southwest England later on Thursday. Rainfall totals of 10-20 mm are expected widely, with as much as 30 mm in the south.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Rain**

Valid from **18:00 on Thu, 24th Oct 2013** until **23:59 on Thu, 24th Oct 2013**

Another band of rain is expected to move north across southwest England during Thursday evening, turning heavy and accompanied by strong southeasterly winds.

The public should be aware of the risk of disruption due to localised flooding.
