Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a frosty start most places will have a fine and sunny day although it will be cloudier across parts of southern and western Scotland. Mainly light winds but breezy across the south making it feel rather cold. This evening and overnight mostly clear skies will allow another widespread and locally sharp frost to form.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Another sunny day after a frosty start on Monday before turning cloudier across eastern parts through the afternoon. A rather cloudy day on Tuesday with some patchy drizzle but most places staying dry. Chilly easterly winds persisting across the south on both days.
