General Situation

The United Kingdom remains under a slack airflow with weak fronts in western parts becoming more active with time but only slowly pushing east.

Low pressure in the Atlantic will push its associated fronts over Shetland and the surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug:

South or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3 becoming mainly northerly later this afternoon.

Smooth or slight.

Isolated showers some sea fog patches.

Moderate to good but locally very poor in sea fog.

Northerly 1 to 3, perhaps locally 4 in the afternoon, becoming variable then west to southwest Wednesday morning.
