General Situation

High pressure close to the east of the United Kingdom will continue to give way to low pressure systems moving in from the west. Various associated frontal systems will move across the United Kingdom over the next couple of days bringing unsettled weather and strong winds to most, however southeastern locations will fair best.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South, backing southwest, 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4.
Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.
Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough, but slight in Moray Firth.
Occasional rain or showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Good becoming moderate later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

occasionally 7 at first in west, decreasing 4 at times in east.
Moderate, becoming rough or very rough in west.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in west.

Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in west.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Southerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in west.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, then becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.
Moderate, occasionally rough in south.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South 6 to gale 8, becoming variable 3, then becoming southeast 4 or 5 later.
Moderate, becoming rough for a time.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in west.
Moderate.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time.
Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low over the Faeroes moves northeast as a cold front clears north of Shetland early Saturday. A ridge of high pressure then builds over the UK, drifting north over Shetland later Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southerly gale force 8.

South, soon backing southwest, 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate later in south and east.

Rain soon clearing.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 02 Apr until 0000 UTC on Sunday 03 Apr:

Southerly 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, backing southeasterly later in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Fair.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

South 3 to 4, occasionally 5 mid channel, backing southeasterly around dawn, locally variable 1 to 3 near the normandy coast in the afternoon, veering south late Saturday evening.

Smooth or slight, perhaps occasionally moderate mid channel.

Risk of showers from afternoon.

Good, locally moderate in any showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 to 5, backing southeast by mid morning, veering south to southwest Sunday evening.

Slight with swell, perhaps occasionally moderate mid channel.

Isolated showers, more frequent Sunday afternoon.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
