General Situation

Areas of low pressure over and around the United Kingdom will bring rather unsettled conditions during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north, becoming variable 3.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, occasional rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south until later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south until later.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Occasional rain or showers, then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough until later in south.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough until later in far east.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, backing southwesterly later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 around headlands in east at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northwesterly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west later.

Thundery showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, backing westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in west.

Smooth or slight, but mainly moderate in far west.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in southwest later.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.

Thundery showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, backing westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in west.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic, then west 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing south or southwest, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East, veering southeast later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast, veering west or southwest for a time 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, then mainly fair.

Isle of Man

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure covers Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northwest becoming variable 2 or 3.

Moderate in western waters otherwise slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:
Variable 2 or 3 becoming east or northeast 3 or 4.
Mainly slight.
Fair.
Good.

Channel Islands
24 hour forecast:
Northeast to north 4 to 5, backing northwest later this evening.
Mainly moderate.
Some morning mist patches scattered thundery showers.
Good, locally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 later in the afternoon, backing west on Tuesday.
Moderate becoming slight.
A risk of showers at first.
Mainly good.

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
