Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

Low in North Sea moving eastwards followed by a temporary ridge of high pressure. Showers at times in all areas with winds gradually moderating.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northwest backing south 6 to gale 8 decreasing 3 or 4.

Showers.

Good.

Rough or very rough, locally moderate in Moray Firth.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9, backing south 3 or 4.

Rain then showers.
