A ridge of high pressure extends south just to the east of Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far east for a time.

Slight in west at first, otherwise mainly moderate.
