Forecast for Wednesday 05 Jul 2023

Weather: Dry, sunny start. Cloud increases through the morning, perhaps giving a few showers. Showers turn more frequent around midday and early afternoon then gradually die out into the evening. Dry with increasing cloud after dark.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 40% at times this morning, rising to 90% in the afternoon

Low cloud and visibility: Generally good visibility outside of any low cloud. Some patchy cloud above 500m in the morning, but lifting above the tops by midday.

Meteorologist's View

High UV levels so sun protection is recommended.

Forecast for Thursday 06 Jul 2023

Weather: Dry but cloudy through the early hours and much of the morning, but increasingly windy. Heavy persistent rain spreads in from the southwest by midday or early afternoon with gales developing across the tops in the afternoon. Rain and strong winds continuing through the evening.

Maximum wind: Southwest 20 gusting 30 mph. Becoming Southerly 30 gusting 45 mph by midday, 35-40 gusting 55 mph late afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 60% in the morning. Nil in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Cloud bases around 500-600m rising above the summits by mid to late morning. Cloud lowering to 300m or less in the afternoon.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 11 Celsius rising to 15 Celsius
At 700m: Plus 7 Celsius rising to 10 Celsius
Freezing level: Above the summits.
