Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Tomorrow will be another unsettled day for most parts of the country with further showers or longer spells of rain, as well as the risk of some hill snow. The best of the drier and brighter weather will be through the central belt of Scotland and parts of southeast England. It will feel rather chilly in the brisk winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Wednesday will be a drier, brighter day with showers largely restricted to coastal areas. Where showers do occur, they will be wintry over the hills and to low levels in the north. Thursday will see sunny spells and scattered showers.
