Meteorologist's View

Strong sunshine and high UV levels bring a high risk of sunburn. Breezy on higher slopes.

Forecast for Thursday 03 Jun 2021

Weather: A cloudier start compared to previous day, this cloud perhaps thick enough to bring one or two showers, mainly across the Southern Fells. The afternoon will be bright with some sunshine but trending cloudier by evening.

Maximum wind: Southeast 20-25mph veering southwest 10-15mph through afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90% falling 60%.

Visibility: Generally no issues with any passing showers doing little to affect visibility. Areas of cloud may develop above around 600m from late afternoon.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 14C rising 17 or 18C.
At 800m: 8 or 9C.
Freezing level: Well above summits.
