Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
England, Wales and southern Scotland will be cloudy with rain, heavy and persistent at times. The heaviest rain will move west into Wales and the Southwest. Southeast England will see the rain turn more showery. In northern Scotland and Northern Ireland, early frost, fog and ice will clear, leading to sunny intervals and isolated showers.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Many areas will be cloudy on Tuesday and Wednesday, rain in places, although the rain tending to die Wednesday. There will be some drier, brighter spells in the south Tuesday, these developing in some northern areas on Wednesday. Temperatures, locally mild, but mostly near normal.
