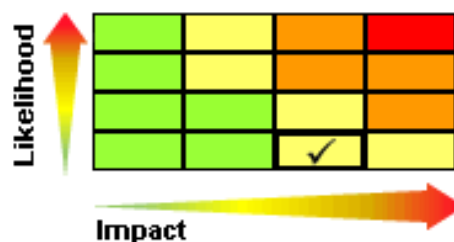
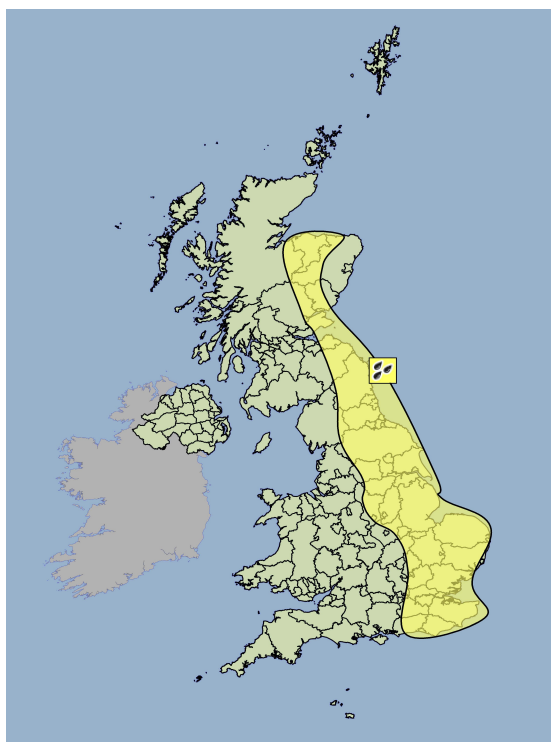




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A slack area of low pressure and a relatively moist airmass will provide the ingredients for some intense showers today. These will probably be focused into slow-moving bands, which increases the risk of localised impacts. Locally 15-20 mm of rain is possible in an hour and perhaps in excess of 30 mm within a 2 hour period. Of course the slow-moving nature also means that areas not too far away could see very little rainfall.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **10:30 on Tue, 08th Jul 2014** until **19:00 on Tue, 08th Jul 2014**

Slow-moving heavy showers, with thunder in places, are likely to develop today across the eastern half of the UK.

The public should be aware of possible surface water flooding, although, as is often the case in such situations, many places will escape the heaviest downpours.

This warning has been updated to extend it further west across northern England and to include southeastern areas.
