#### General Situation

The ridge of high pressure over the United Kingdom today will drift away eastwards as a large area of low pressure over the Atlantic pushes its fronts into the United Kingdom during Tuesday and Wednesday to mark the start of another cool and unsettled spell of weather.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.

The Minch  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable mainly south or southwest, backing east or southeast, 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Occasional rain or showers but mainly fair.

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in south.  
Mainly fair, rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southwesterly, backing easterly or southeasterly, 2 or 3, occasionally 4, increasing 4 or 5 in south later.  
Moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers but mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, and far north.  
Slight or moderate.

## Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or less in west.  
Moderate or rough.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 04 Jul until 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Jul:

Variable 2 to 4.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East or variable 2 to 3, very soon backing northeast to north, increasing mainly 4 by late afternoon, perhaps 5 for a time jersey southeastwards, veering east 2 to 3 overnight becoming variable later.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate this evening.

Fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or east 1 to 3, becoming mainly south to southwest overnight.

Smooth or slight.

Outbreaks of rain spreading from the west during the morning.

Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
