General Situation

An unseasonably cold northeasterly flow will be maintained between high pressure to the northwest of the United Kingdom and low pressure over the near Continent. The wind will always remain strongest across the south.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure extending southeast towards Shetland will gradually decline, with a depression expected to track east to the north of the area during Friday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming mainly north or northwest 2 or 3.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Friday 05 Apr until 1800 UTC on Friday 05 Apr:

North or northwest 2 or 3, backing west 3 or 4 occasionally 5, then veering north or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time in the northeast.

Slight or moderate, becoming mainly moderate.

Fair at first, occasional rain or showers developing.

Good, becoming moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 6 to gale 8, locally 5 to 6 in the south of the area at first and in the north by Friday evening.

Moderate to rather rough in the south, rather rough to rough in the north.

Wintry showers in the north and west at first occasional rain or sleet in the south and east spreading northwest, becoming persistent and locally heavy at times from morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 6, perhaps locally 7 at first, decreasing 4 to 5 by dawn and 3 to 4 Saturday afternoon.

Moderate to rather rough, locally rough at first becoming slight to moderate.

Rain or sleet, locally heavy at first, gradually clearing Friday night.

Moderate to poor in rain or sleet, becoming good.

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
