Forecast for Monday 09 Aug 2021

Weather: Mainly dry in the south overnight with a few clear spells, but cloudy with outbreaks of rain over Assynt and the north. The north will be cloudy during the day with occasional rain, perhaps pushing into Skye at times. However, Knoydart and the more sheltered south will see any low cloud and mist lifting and clearing during the morning with bright or sunny spells developing. Here a few well scattered heavy showers possible in the afternoon and early evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% in north and 80% in the south.

Visibility: Mainly good or very good, but moderate or poor in rain and heavy showers. Also any early mist and low cloud. Occasional or extensive cloud, well down at first with base 600m or less, but lifting and breaking above the summits in the south in the afternoon, but remaining lower and more extensive in the north.

Forecast for Tuesday 10 Aug 2021

Weather: Mostly dry and rather cloudy overnight, but the odd shower possible with low cloud and mist. Most of the low cloud and mist lifting and breaking during the morning to leave a dry and bright day with a few sunny spells possible.

Maximum wind: West or Southwest 5 to 15mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% becoming 80% by afternoon.

Visibility: Mostly good or very good, but poor or very poor in morning low cloud and mist. Occasional or extensive cloud, base 600 to 900m, rising near or above the summits in the afternoon.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 12 Celsius rising to 19 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 8 to 11 Celsius
Freezing level: Above the summits.
