### Forecast for Wednesday 06 Jul 2022

**Weather:** Cloudy at first with some mist on the tops of northern and western hills allowing for some drizzle or at times. Much clearer by lunchtime with some strong sunshine in the afternoon but clouding over again overnight. Breezy on hill tops.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 40% at first becoming 100% by lunchtime and then 60% overnight.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Widespread cloud with bases around 400m will cover northern and western slopes, clearer for more southeastern hills. All cloud above the summits by lunchtime. Patchy cloud will return to northern and western slopes with bases around 500m in the evening.

**Forecast for Thursday 07 Jul 2022**

**Weather:** A dry day, mostly cloudy in the morning, much clearer and sunnier in the afternoon and evening. Feeling warm in the sunshine. Becoming calmer through the day.

**Maximum wind:** Northwesterly 15mph gust 25mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m:** 80% at first, becoming 100% by mid-morning.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Patchy cloud with bases around 500m will cover hill tops in northern and western regions but will soon lift to leave all cloud above the summits by mid-morning.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 23 Celsius.  
**At 600m:** Plus 14 Celsius.  
**Freezing level:** Above the summits.
