### Forecast for Friday 02 Apr 2021

**Weather:** A dry, but rather cloudy start to the morning with occasional sunny spells, especially on western slopes. Frequent bright or sunny spells developing for all parts by the end of the morning leaving a fine afternoon and evening with light winds.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 100%, but 80% until mid-morning on eastern slopes.

**Visibility:** A few patches of low cloud above 450-600m on eastern summits at first, though soon clearing. Some slight haze at low elevations. Otherwise very good or excellent clarity throughout.

## Forecast for Saturday 03 Apr 2021

**Weather:** Another cloudy start to the morning, but staying dry. A few brighter intervals developing by midday, then lengthy sunny periods forming through the afternoon and continuing into the evening.

**Maximum wind:** Northeasterly 20mph, gusts 30mph.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 100%, but 80% until mid-morning on eastern slopes.

**Visibility:** A few patches of low cloud above 450-600m on eastern summits at first, though soon clearing. Some slight haze at low elevations. Otherwise very good or excellent clarity throughout.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Around plus 2 Celsius, rising to plus 9 Celsius by day in the east, plus 12 Celsius in the west  
**At 600m:** Around minus 1 Celsius, rising to plus 5 Celsius by day  
**Freezing level:** 500m rising above summits by day
