#### General Situation

The United Kingdom will continue to lie in an unstable and showery airflow. As an area of high pressure develops to the north of Scotland today, the flow will gradually veer easterly or northeasterly.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Northeast backing north 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 in the west and north of the area, increasing 6 to 7 overnight in the northwest of the area.

Slight to moderate with a low swell, increasing rather rough to rough after midnight in the northwest.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, some hail and sleet mist patches tonight and at first tomorrow near the normandy coast.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast, 3 to 4 at times in the far southeast of the area, otherwise 5 to 7.

Rather rough to rough in the northwest, slight to moderate in the southeast.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, some hail and sleet mist patches later near the normandy coast.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
