Forecast for Tuesday 04 Jan 2022

Weather: Frequent snow showers and a few sunny or clear intervals. Blizzard conditions likely at times and the odd longer spell of snow.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%

Visibility: Often very poor in snow showers and blowing snow, cloud occasionally lowering to 600-750m in showers, but good away from showers and cloud.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Note the very low feels like temperatures on the table. Gusts of over 70mph likely on the Plateau.

Forecast for Wednesday 05 Jan 2022

Weather: The snow showers will become more scattered overnight, leaving a few lighter ones over the Lecht and Ladder Hills, even these dying out during the day. Most areas will become dry with long sunny periods, and staying dry in the evening.

Maximum wind: Northwest 50 gusts 70mph in early hours easing 40 gusts 55mph by dawn, easing 30 gusts 40mph by evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40% in the morning in the northeast otherwise 80% or more.

Visibility: Mainly very good by day, perhaps poor in any early showers in the northeast.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 2 Celsius at dawn rising to Plus 2 in the afternoon, back down to Minus 4 to Minus 7 in the evening.
At 800m: Minus 6 Celsius.
Freezing level: All levels.
