Forecast for Wednesday 02 Feb 2022

Weather: The majority will stay dry with only a little patchy light rain or drizzle appearing, largely restricted to western and northern peaks. Cloud breaks appearing most readily in south and east.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Ranging from 35% in northwest and 80% in southeast

Low cloud and visibility: Good or very good becoming moderate or poor in patchy rain and drizzle, very poor in hill fog with bases quite extensive above 500m in northwest, only sporadically so in southeast.

Forecast for Thursday 03 Feb 2022

Weather: Cloudier than Wednesday with occasional showers, these focused across western peaks, mainly during the morning, before dwindling through the afternoon. Band of more organised rain reaching from the northwest during the late evening.

Maximum wind: West or southwest mean 25-30mph with gusts reaching 45mph across most exposed ridges and summits.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Ranging from 25% and in west 75% in east

Low cloud and visibility: Good becoming moderate or poor in showers, very poor in hill fog with occasional bases above 600m in west, only isolated in east.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 4 Celsius increasing 13 Celsius during the afternoon
At 600m: Plus 5 Celsius
Freezing level: 1300m
