Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 01 May to 1800 UTC Monday 02 May 2022

General Situation

The low pressure stretched over Scotland and Ireland drifts south and finally fills on Monday. Outbreaks of rain or drizzle and occasional patches of fog clear from the north for a time.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 to 5, veering northeast later in Moray Firth.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, then moderate or rough later in north.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 2 to 4, becoming variable 4 or less, then southeast 3 to 5 later.

Occasionally rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 2 to 4 becoming variable 4 or less, then north or northeast 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first, becoming poor at times later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then south or southeast 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in north.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 4 or less, then north 3 or 4 later.

Slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4, veering east or northeast 2 or 3, then southeast 3 to 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4, then north 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 3 or 4, veering east or northeast 2 to 4, then southeast 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight, occasionally moderate later in north.
Showers.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southeasterly 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less.
Smooth, occasionally slight in northeast.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, veering easterly 2 or 3 later.
Smooth, becoming smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor, becoming good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 for a time later in east.
Smooth, occasionally slight in west.
Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4 later in east.
Smooth, occasionally slight in west, becoming smooth or slight later.
Showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 4 or less, then north or northwest 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate at first in west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then west or southwest 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing south, 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then north or northwest 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in southwest, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches for a time in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in north.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight becoming smooth.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 or less.

Smooth.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South 2 or 3, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then northwesterly 3 or 4 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4 at first in the North Channel, otherwise variable 3 or less, becoming northwesterly 3 or 4 later in the North Channel.

Smooth, occasionally slight in the North Channel.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4 at first in the North Channel, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth, occasionally slight in the North Channel.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in southeast, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain, fog patches, becoming fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Showers later.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 4 or less, then south or southwest 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight in south.

Showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

North or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 4 or less, then south or southwest 3 to 5 later.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak weather front will push south through Shetland early on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

South or southeast 3 or 4 veering north or northwest 5 or 6
Slight or moderate
Patchy rain, drizzle and mist with a risk of fog patches, becoming fair
Good, occasionally poor or very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 02 May until 1800 UTC on Monday 02 May:
North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first
Moderate or rough
Mainly fair

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 5, decreasing 1 to 2 at times, mainly in the far north and far southeast of the area.
Smooth or slight with a low swell.
Rain or drizzle at times until later, mainly in the northwest of the area, locally persistent at first.
Moderate or good, locally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North to northeast 2 to 4, backing northwesterly 1 to 2 in the northwest of the area.
Smooth or slight with a low swell.
Fair or fine.
