General Situation

Over the next couple of days, a slack area of low pressure will remain over biscay and France, while high pressure across Scotland builds southwards.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Ridge of high pressure moving east across Shetland waters during Monday with a weak trough of low pressure following from west during evening and Monday night.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West backing southwest 4 or 5
Slight or moderate
Mainly fair
Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Jul until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Jul:

Southwesterly veering westerly 3 or 4 occasionally 5 in west at first
Slight or moderate
Fair then patchy rain and fog patches
Good becoming moderate occasionally very poor

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast or variable guernsey southwards, northeast to east 4 to 5 guernsey northwards perhaps occasionally 6 this morning gusty around showers.

Slight, occasionally moderate in the north.

Isolated thundery showers mist patches.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3 guernsey southwards east to northeast 4 to 5 guernsey northwards decreasing 3 to 4 by afternoon becoming variable 1 to 3 by evening.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the north until midday.

Isolated showers mist patches risk of fog patches overnight.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor at times, and very poor in any fog.

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
