Forecast for Friday 08 Jul 2022

Weather: Early morning cloud will readily break up after sunrise, leaving a predominantly sunny day, albeit with the sunshine turning rather hazy at times. With light winds, it will feel very warm, especially low down and in shelter.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 30% becoming 100% by mid-morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Areas of cloud 400-500 metres, breaking up through the morning, with summits clear thereafter. Generally good, if not sparkling visibility outside of any cloud.

Meteorologist's View

Strong sunshine will bring the risk of sunburn. High temperatures coupled with light winds will lead to the risk of heat exhaustion and dehydration, especially on long climbs.

Forecast for Saturday 09 Jul 2022

Weather: Early cloud breaking up to leave a dry, sunny and warm day. Strong sunshine and high low-level temperatures will bring an elevated risk of sunburn, dehydration and heat exhaustion.

Maximum wind: Northwest veering northeast, 15-20 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 60% until soon after dawn, becoming 100% thereafter.

Low cloud and visibility: Patches of cloud above between 400 and 600 metres until soon after dawn, becoming nil by mid-morning. Very good visibility expected outside of any cloud, with distant hills clearly visible.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 11 Celsius becoming plus 24 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 11 Celsius becoming plus 14 Celsius.
Freezing level: Well above the summits.
