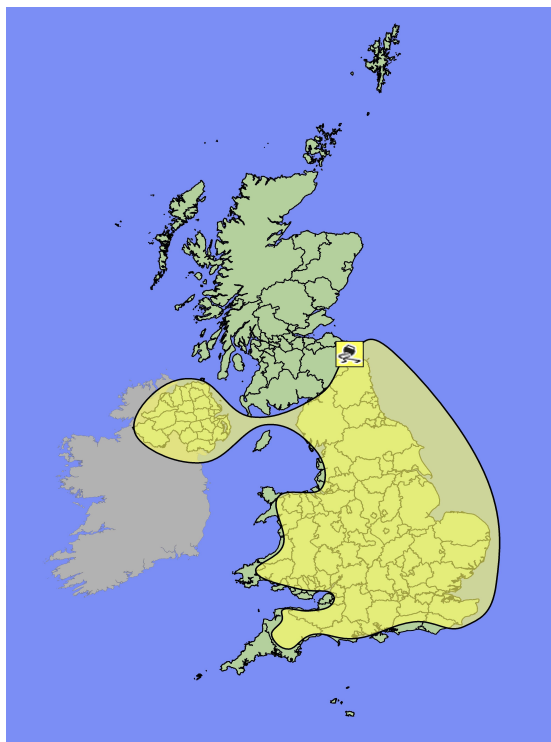




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Wintry showers will extend south into England and Wales, giving a covering of snow in places inland, especially over high ground. As temperatures fall, ice will form readily on untreated roads and pavements.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **00:05 on Tue, 05th Feb 2013** until **11:00 on Tue, 05th Feb 2013**

Wintry showers and strong winds will continue in many areas overnight, although some clearer spells will develop in the south and east. Surfaces will remain wet from earlier showers and from continued showers of rain, sleet and snow, allowing ice to form. Localised accumulations of 2-5 cm of snow are possible outside of the separate snow warning areas, particularly in the west, (chiefly above 200 metres in the southwest).

The public should be aware of the risk of icy stretches on untreated roads and pavements.
