Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Friday 04 October to 1200 UTC Saturday 05 October 2019

General Situation

Low pressure centred over Ireland will quickly fill today and move steadily southeastwards, eventually losing its identity over France on Saturday. Further Atlantic fronts will then begin to move into the west during the day on Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering southeast 5 to 7 later.

Moderate, becoming slight for a time in Moray Firth, then occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering southeast 5 or 6 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, veering southeast 3 or 4 later.

Moderate.

Rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Moderate.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

West veering northeast 4 or 5, then veering east 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 2 to 4, veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight.
Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 or 6, veering northeasterly, then southeasterly later, 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate in north.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 or 6, veering northerly then easterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 2 to 4, veering southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, then veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 to 7, veering north 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming south 4 or 5, then veering west or southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 or 7, decreasing 3 to 5, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming mainly rough in west.

Showers, rain for a time.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4 later, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest, veering northwest later, 4 to 6.
Moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Showers, rain for a time.
Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in south, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6, then southeasterly 3 to 5 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southeasterly, veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, rain for a time.
Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic, becoming northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, veering southeasterly 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in southwest.
Mainly fair, occasional rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly, veering westerly or northwesterly later, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.
Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeast, veering east or southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast veering west later, 5 or 6.
Mainly moderate.
Rain, fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 to 6, veering southeast 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 5 to 7, veering west or northwest 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering southeast 4 to 6 later, then occasionally 7 later near Mull of Kintyre.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Mainly fair, occasionally rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first near Mull of Kintyre, veering north or northwest 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly veering southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, then increasing 6 or 7 later.

Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, veering northwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering southeasterly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in central areas.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, veering southeasterly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in south.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Friday 04 Oct 2019 at 1200 UTC until Saturday 05 Oct 2019 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure extending southeast across Shetland water declines north as a low pushes east across central UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in the west, veering southeasterly 3 or 4 later

Moderate, rough in the west.

Fair

Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 05 Oct until 1200 UTC on Saturday 05 Oct:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 in south and west, perhaps 6 later in the far west.

Moderate, rough in the west.

Mainly fair, isolated showers.

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 to 7, perhaps locally gale 8 mid channel early afternoon, decreasing 5 to 6 this evening and veering northwest, further decreasing 4 to 5 by morning, backing west 2 to 4 by midday.

Rough, locally very rough in the north and west of the area this afternoon, decreasing moderate to rather rough by morning and mainly slight by midday.

Isolated showers, locally prolonged from later this evening, then occasional rain from morning.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers or rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 2 to 4, backing southwest during the afternoon, increasing 4 to 5 by midnight, veering northwest by morning, increasing 5 to 6 in the morning.

Slight, increasing moderate to rather rough in the morning with a low swell.

Occasional rain, becoming persistent overnight, locally heavy with the slight risk of thunder, clearing by morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor overnight, becoming good by morning.

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
