Forecast for Friday 09 Feb 2024

Weather: Cloudy with outbreaks of snow. Snow will become persistent from the morning with the snow expected to fall to low levels. Falls will be widespread and heavy at times.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 10%, but 30% towards western Perthshire.

Low Cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud 600-800m falling to lower slopes in snow, bases a bit higher and more broken west of the A9. The visibility will fall very poor in snow.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist’s View

It will be very cold with gale force winds and persistent snow making walking and navigation difficult.

Forecast for Saturday 10 Feb 2024

Weather: Cloudy conditions continue through the day with snow, widespread through the morning, turning to rain at lower levels by the afternoon. Becoming drier towards the evening.

Maximum wind: Northeast 20-25mph gust 40mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 20%

Low Cloud and visibility: Extensive cloud 400-600m falling to lower slopes in snow and later rain. The visibility will be moderate, falling very poor in snow and rain.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 2 Celsius rising plus 4 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 1 Celsius.
Freezing level: Surface to 200m rising to 800m towards evening.
