Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 03 November to 0000 UTC Tuesday 04 November 2014

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure between Iceland and Scotland will sink southeastwards, crossing the United Kingdom during Monday and Monday night. This low will gradually move away eastwards leaving a cool northerly airflow across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming cyclonic, then northeasterly later in north, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 4 at first in east, otherwise northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.

Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, and very rough later in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 or 3, then north or northeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight.
Showers, thundery later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, decreasing 4 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly becoming variable later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.
Slight.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9, decreasing 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.
Moderate or rough.
Rain then thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.
Rain then thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 or 5, veering northwest 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.
Rain then thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West veering north or northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later in north.
Slight in Liverpool Bay, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming mainly slight later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic, becoming mainly northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 or 4, becoming north or northwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic, becoming mainly northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, except in southeast.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for

a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in North Channel.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic, becoming mainly northerly 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in North Channel.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South becoming cyclonic, then north later, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time in west.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly backing southeasterly, then northeasterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north, decreasing 3 for a time.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly or northeasterly 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, then very rough in north.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly backing southeasterly, then northeasterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north, decreasing 3 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly or northeasterly 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.
Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Monday 03 Nov 2014 at 0000 UTC until Monday 03 Nov 2014 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Southwesterly flow over Shetland waters eases Monday morning as complex Atlantic low approaches West Scotland, extending a trough over Shetland water in the afternoon.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Southwest 4 or 5 backing south 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 03 Nov until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov:
Southerly backing easterly 3 or 4, then northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later in northwest.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in northwest.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest to west 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8, decreasing 5 to 6 in the morning, then 4 to 5 in the evening.
Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough in the afternoon.
Occasional rain, locally heavy, clearing mid-morning, then scattered showers from early afternoon with a risk of thunder.
Good except in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest to west 4 to 5, veering northwest in the morning.
Moderate to rather rough with swell, becoming slight to moderate.
Scattered showers, with a risk of thunder, dying out.
Good except in showers.

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
