General Situation

Pressure will fall over the United Kingdom through the weekend bringing more unsettled conditions.

A low pressure is expected to develop over southern and eastern areas during Sunday, bringing
thunderly downpours and a risk of gusty winds later.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Variable 3 or less.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Southerly becoming variable then mainly northerly 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Thunderly showers, fog patches.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thunderly showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly becoming variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, thunderly at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Smooth or slight.

Thunderly rain or showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Variable or cyclonic becoming northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly easterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers developing.

Good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming cyclonic then westerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 at times later in west.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Thundery rain or showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly northerly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers developing, fog patches for a time in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing westerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time later.

Slight, becoming moderate at times later.

Rain or showers, thundery at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Mainly northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in west.

Occasional drizzle in west, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing west 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Mainly west or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in east.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:

Mainly southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable later.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional drizzle, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northwesterly 3, increasing 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3, occasionally 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional drizzle, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times near Mull of Galloway.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northwesterly later, 3 or less.
Smooth.
Mainly fair, fog patches developing for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly northwesterly, backing westerly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly northerly 3, occasionally 4 in northeast.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional drizzle, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 in northeast.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far northwest.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly northerly later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly northwesterly, becoming variable later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time through North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in west.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Good, becoming moderate, occasionally very poor.

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southerly at first, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.

Occasional rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Variable, becoming mainly northerly, 3.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.

Showers, fog patches, mainly fair later.

Slight or moderate.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fog patches, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will continue to decay as a weak weather front edges into Shetland during Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south at first.

Slight.

Outbreaks of rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Sunday 06 Jun:

Southeast veering south or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Outbreaks of rain.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 2 or 3 backing northwest to west by morning, increasing 3 to 4 later.

Slight.

Some sea fog patches scattered showers in the evening.

Moderate to good but locally very poor in sea fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 to 4 increasing 4 to 5 for a time in the afternoon, backing west later.

Slight becoming moderate for a time.

Occasional showers and some sea fog patches, mostly clearing by morning.

Good, occasionally moderate to very poor overnight.

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
