Headline:

Early frost. Mostly dry, rain later in northwest. Sunny spells.

Today:

England/Wales staying dry, with frost and any fog clearing slowly and some sunny spells. Cloud and wind increasing across Scotland/N.Ireland, rain reaching the northwest later.

Tonight:

Rain reaching Wales, the north and southwest of England, becoming more patchy. Scotland/N.Ireland becoming clearer, with showers in far north.

Outlook for Tuesday:

Cloud and patchy rain crossing E.Anglia and SE.England. Brighter elsewhere, temperatures falling quickly in afternoon.
