Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Friday 03 April to 1200 UTC Saturday 04 April 2020

#### General Situation

High pressure centred southwest of the United Kingdom will move slowly southeastwards. Low pressure will develop in the Atlantic during Saturday bringing strong southerly winds to western parts later.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southeast 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 to 6.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming south 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 to 6, backing southeast 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south or southeast, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later in far west.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 or 4, backing southerly, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4 or 5, backing southeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough later in the North

Channel.  
Fair.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing south 4 to 6.

Rough at first in west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers then occasional rain, fair later.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 to 6, backing southeast 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough, occasionally very rough later in far west.

Fair.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing south or southwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, then rain for a time.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 to 6, backing southeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate becoming rough.

Fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing south or southwest 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, then rain for a time.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 to 6, backing southeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in far west.

Fair.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

The strong, cold northwesterly airstream continues to ease as low pressure over Scandinavia moves away east.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northwesterly 4 or 5 decreasing 3 later in southwest.

Mainly rough

Wintry showers

Good, occasionally poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 04 Apr until 1200 UTC on Saturday 04 Apr:

Northwesterly becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming southeasterly 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough  
Wintry showers, rain later  
Good occasionally moderate or poor

Channel Islands  
24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 2 to 4, occasionally variable 1 to 3 this evening, becoming southeast 3 to 4 overnight.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of isolated showers at first local mist or fog patches developing overnight near the french coast.

Good, locally moderate to very poor near french coast overnight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 6 during the evening, perhaps locally 7 mid-channel from dawn, veering southeast to south later.

Smooth or slight, increasing slight to moderate overnight, perhaps rather rough in the far northwest later.

Mainly fair or fine.
