#### General Situation

A large, slow-moving area of high pressure centred over the United Kingdom will bring settled conditions to most areas, although fog patches are likely at times with drizzle in the far north.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, moderate becoming rough north and west of Orkney.

Shetland Isles

#### General Situation

A weak frontal trough affecting Shetland at first, with a ridge building behind later on Friday. Icelandic low extends another trough over Shetland on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8 continuing. (Issued at 2128UTC on Thursday 1st October 2015)

Westerly 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, backing southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in far southeast.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later in shelter east of Shetland.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct until 1200 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate but slight at first in shelter east of Shetland.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 4 to 5, occasionally 6 this afternoon, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, further decreasing 1 to 3 Saturday morning and becoming locally variable.

Slight to moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly or variable 1 to 3, becoming southeast overnight, increasing 4 to 6 during the morning, perhaps 7 in the west of the area later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight to moderate.

Fair.
