Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 to 1200 UTC

General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the eastern Atlantic with weak fronts moving south across the United Kingdom. A developing low will bring more unsettled conditions to the northeast later.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 5 or 6 later, occasionally 7 later in north. Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north. Occasional rain, showers later in north. Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later. Moderate or rough, but slight at times in Moray Firth. Showers, squally for a time in east. Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5 later, occasionally 6 later in north. Slight. Occasional rain, fog patches for a time. Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 around Rattray Head. Slight becoming moderate. Occasional rain then showers. Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly northeasterly 3 or 4. Slight. Occasional rain, fog patches for a time. Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later. Slight becoming moderate. Occasional rain, then showers. Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Mainly northerly veering southeasterly for a time 3 or 4. Slight. Occasional rain. Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later. Slight becoming moderate in north. Occasional rain. Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4, occasionally 5 in far west, becoming variable 3 later.

Mainly slight, but moderate at first in west.

Fair, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far west.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 becoming variable 3 later.

Moderate at first in west, otherwise slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Variable becoming northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far southwest.
Occasional rain.

Northwesterly veering northerly 3 or 4.
Slight.
Occasional rain, fog patches for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later in west.
Slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

West or northwest, veering northeast later, 3 or 4.

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 through North Channel.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, fog patches for a time, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

Northwesterly 3 or 4, veering northerly 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, fog patches for a time, showers later.
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A shallow depression will move southeast close to Shetland on Wednesday. A ridge of high pressure will then build over the Norwegian Sea.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northeast at first.

Moderate.

Rain.

Moderate or good.
