An area of low pressure centred to the west of Scotland will gradually move northeastwards and fill.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel - (SWW)

Westerly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southerly later.
