High pressure persisting to the north and northeast of the United Kingdom, while a complex area of low pressure remains to the southwest. This will maintain the easterly or southeasterly airflow for the coming days.

General Situation
High pressure will be slow moving to the north of Shetland and then surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil in operation at time of issue.

East or northeast 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 01 Apr until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 02 Apr:

East or northeast becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5 overnight.

Smooth or slight, increasing slight to moderate overnight.

Some mist or fog patches at first, especially near french coasts risk of thundery showers late afternoon and perhaps some rain around dawn tomorrow.

Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3 in the evening and becoming variable overnight.

Slight to moderate with a decreasing swell, becoming smooth or slight overnight.

Perhaps a little rain at first and again overnight.

Moderate to good.
