Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 01 July to 1200 UTC Tuesday 02 July 2013

General Situation

The United Kingdom will be under the influence of a westerly flow on Monday with pressure still quite high to the south. On Tuesday though an area of low pressure will approach from the west, bringing fronts and stronger winds for a time.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, backing south later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Moderate or rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough at first north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.
Fair then rain.
Good, becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight, becoming mainly moderate except in shelter.
Fair then rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.
Mainly slight.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time, veering west 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Rain for a time.
Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, but variable for a time, 3 or 4.
Slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.
Slight.
Rain for a time.

Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Mainly slight.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, backing southerly later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times in lyme bay, backing southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in west.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, veering west or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Rain or drizzle for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or drizzle later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west, 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Rain or drizzle for a time.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.
Rain or drizzle for a time.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, backing south and increasing 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or drizzle for a time.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, backing south and increasing 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough, then slight or moderate later.
Rain or drizzle for a time.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West backing south, 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair, rain later.
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time, veering west 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.
Rain, showers later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly backing southerly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in North Channel.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time, veering westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.

Rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers then fair, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Very rough, becoming rough.

Showers then fair, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.

Rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 01 Jul 2013 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 02 Jul 2013 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A depression near the Faeroes will move slowly north with an associated front moving east across Shetland on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8.

Southwest 5 or 6 occasionally 4 later.

Rough or very rough, but moderate just east of Shetland.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul:

Southwest backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 2 or 4, backing south to southeast by morning.

Slight.

Fair to cloudy some drizzle in the west of the area Tuesday morning.

Good, locally poor tomorrow.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 4, veering southwest and increasing 4 or 5 by evening, perhaps 6 mid channel, veering west overnight.

Slight, becoming moderate, locally rather rough in the north.

Cloudy with some rain or drizzle and some coastal fog patches, clearing by morning.

Moderate to good, becoming poor or very poor at times.

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
